

Geology institute, KU Leuven

At the Arenberg campus, at Celestijnenlaan 200, the existing Geo Institute of the Leuven Catholic University was renovated and extended with a new building.

The existing Geo Institute of the Leuven Catholic University was renovated and extended by a new building, so that the complete institute, now dispersed over the town, can be housed in this new complex. The newly built section of some 8000 m² includes 10 lecture rooms, 20 labs and work stations, offices for 165 persons, 7 pool offices, 5 administrative offices, 3 meeting rooms, and social and logistic infrastructure. The different laboratories will be housed in the 1500-m² section earmarked for renovation. Here, Ingenium performed design work for the technical systems and provided guidance during their execution.
