The Saint John hospital in Bruges renewed its redundant data centre and has now two full-fledged data centres. After examining the possibilities it was decided to keep this redundant data centre on the site. The white space is approximately 200 m² and meets the Tier 3 requirements. The challenge in this was to house the data centre in a basement containing already technical installations. In addition, a fiberglass network was laid out and a new high-voltage cabin was installed. All this in order to achieve Tier 3 level.
