

## Arts centre STUK

The arts centre opened in 2001 in the renovated Arenberg building of the university in the centre of Leuven. STUK is now a small city in the city, a collection of spaces and places that each enter into an alliance with a single purpose (film, music, theatre) but which allow for change over time.

The complex comprises some ten halls and rooms; a theatre hall, a dance rehearsal room, a lab room, a cinema, an outdoor theatre ...

The Soete hall with its 221 seats is the largest hall in this arts centre. It is a flat-floor auditorium with fixed transverse lighting bridges. Between the bridges, mobile hoists are suspended.
